The Commissioner of Fire and Rescue NSW support's this position.

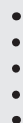
There are two main types of residential smoke alarms photoelectric and ionisation

PHOTOELECTRIC SMOKE ALARMS

- Give earlier warning of smouldering fires (the most common domestic fire), than other kinds of alarms.
- Photoelectric smoke alarms provide the best detection across a range of fires according to research by the Australasian Fire and Emergency Service Authorities Council (AFAC)
- They are more likely to alert occupants in time to escape safely.
